The Jesuit theologian Karl Rahner's fingerprints are all over the documents of the Second Vatican Council. He served there as a *peritus* (theological consultant) and his theological ideas were instrumental in the final formulation of many of the documents. This talk will begin with an exploration of the Ignatian spirituality that ignited and motivated Karl Rahner in everything he did, and then show how his influence is particularly visible in the Council's documents. We will end with Rahner's own assessment of the importance of the Second Vatican Council for the future development of Christ's Church.
