1. **Season of creation updates**: Kate. Theme : Justice and Peace will Flow...song suggestions, Tend the Ground and/or River Songs. Denise will let organists know.

2. 10/1: **outdoor prayer in 4 directions** after 11:00Mass (Kate) followed by dedication of Kateri garden sight. (Need to know if Fr. G will be celebrant at 11:00 Mass)

Oct. 1 Kate brought up that this is the same day as Malachi/Patrick meeting in the hall directly after Mass. Kate and Brian: check with Fr. G about prayer in 4 directions and blessing of Kateri garden. Kate mentioned maybe moving it to following Sunday (also check to make sure Fr. G. Will be celebrant, or at least there at end of Mass).

3. Claire design Kateri Garden insert for the bulletin asap, get ok from Fr. Gurnick.

Claire will check with Brian about garden flier insert for Sept. 17. Judy suggested putting flier for "The Letter" (Sept 28 event) back to back with garden flier. Mary Grace has The Letter flier. Coordination needed ASAP.

4. Claire organize **Kateri garden work day** on Sept. 30 (what does this involve? Preparing soil? Planting? ) Recruit parishioner helpers. Does this date still work? Who on this team commits to being there?

Claire is waiting on soil test return. Bill checked (see his email) to make sure there was no cement from old school below sod. All is ok. Claire emailed us garden design and flowers. She will purchase mulch and flowers with Amy for planting at 10 AM on Sept. 30th. Claire will contact Jared about sod preparation before the 30th. Judy suggested refreshments. (I'd be happy to order and pick up donuts. Claire said \$ would be covered.)

\*rain date (storming, not light rain) Oct. 7.

\*Important conversation about watering. Where is our water source and does a long enough hose or attachment hose have to be purchased? Where is hose stored and how will we have access to it after 4:00? Claire will ask Fr. G to help problem solve watering issue.

Kate, Mary Grace, and Claire volunteered to days for watering for one month after planting. (depending on rain). (I can't remember days for each).

5. Jared, rent sod digger and prepare garden site before 9/30.
