I. Updates/Feedback/Responses

- A. Kateri Garden Blessing/Maintenance/News Bench/Statue (Claire Foley/Judy
 - O)
- a. discussion about signage for garden
- b. register as a St. Kateri site/pollinator highway (Judy O.)
- c. continue working with parish to locate bench/statue
- d. Homework: Jared get sample signage; Judy research with which organizations we should register the garden (e.g. pollinator highway, Kateri Habitats); Claire talk to Fr Gurnick about the statue and bench and signage
- B. NEORSD Sewer Grant (Jared Bartley)
 - **a.** Environmental Design Group (EDG) has started doing field tests and survey work that will eventually inform some of the design work.
 - **b.** Meeting between Scott, Brenna, Jared and EDG will happen at the end of November.
 - c. Design will be completed by the spring.
 - **d.** Next grant for construction will be due in September 2024. If we are awarded money, construction would begin in Spring 2025.
- **C.** October Litter Pilgrimage (Kate Campbell)
 - a. Kate attended. 12 people attended, including some from the Sisters of St. Joseph. It took place at St Colman. The Nov 11 litter pilgrimage was organized by Calvary Reformed Church and met at the park at W 75th and Madison
- D. Westside Creation Care Team meeting and Thanksgiving potluck (MG)
 - **a.** There is a potluck this Wednesday, we are all invited. It will be at St. Paul's community church at 7pm. Mary Grace and Brian will go.
 - b. Discussion about the situation where CMSD and the City entered a land swap agreement to build a new school on Cudell Park. It would involve taking down old trees. There is a lawsuit going on to stop the construction and preserve the park.

- c. Judy went to the rally at the Ohio Statehouse for Ohio nature and democracy. About 100 people attended. Lots of discussion about gerrymandering, as it will impact decision-making about fracking.
