ST. PATRICK with ST. MALACHI PSR GUIDELINES



St Patrick with St Malachi PSR uses a "Family Faith Formation" model that consists of two inperson sessions a month with a Virtus-trained and background checked Catechist PLUS three lessons completed at home with parents for each 5 session Unit in the Student book.

In-person sessions occur in St Patrick Club Building Faith Formation Center (FFC). We gather in the "grand atrium" for opening song and prayer at 9:45 AM, then break into grade level classrooms. We conclude at 10:45 AM. This provides families the option of attending 8:30 or 11AM Mass at St. Patrick, which is strongly encouraged. First Sunday Family Mass at 5PM generally occurs Oct thru May.

PSR Curriculum for K- Grade 8 is Loyola Press *Finding God* Family Catechesis. This curriculum is approved by the US Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) for scope and content.

Finding God has 5 Units, each with a particular focus, as found in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC). Parents meet in the Oak Room with the Catechetical Leader for each Unit Opener to discuss and share faith on the Unit's topic, which is uniform for K-Gr 6, and enriches parents for at-home lessons.

The Oak Room (with coffee) is available for parents, babies, toddlers on non-Parent Meeting days.

A *Finding God* session is listed for <u>each week</u> on the PSR Calendar. For non-in-person weeks, the lesson is completed at home using the Loyola Press Parent Guide, found here:

Grades 7 & 8 uses a "flipped classroom" model where <u>all</u> sessions are completed at home and students pray, discuss the lesson content, and engage in service for PSR and Parish community during in-person gatherings. This content does not follow the Gr 1-6 schema for a lesson.

<u>Three PSR Service Projects</u> supported by PSR Parents and Students, include:

- Box of Joy in September and October
- St Patrick Giving Tree in November and December
- Malachi Center Charity of the Month in March

<u>Intergenerational Gatherings</u> occur during PSR for All Saints Day, Advent Lessons & Carols, and Lenten Stations of the Cross. All family members are welcome to attend these family-friendly celebrations.

Preparation for Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Communion, Confirmation are in addition to PSR.

Registration Fee of \$30 covers cost of materials and Student Book; scholarships are available on request
